

PERRY TOWNSHIP LEAF COLLECTION GUIDELINES



Leaf collection for the 2022 season will begin on Monday, October 17th, and end on Thursday, December 1st. Route information and schedule updates will be posted on the Perry Township website at www.perrytwp.org/2277/Fall-Leaf-Collection and on our Facebook page: [Perry Township, Franklin County](#).

We ask that you follow these regulations:

- Leaf piles **must** be no wider than 6 feet and placed in your yard at the edge of the road, **NOT in the road**.
- All piles must be free of branches, dirt, flowers, and mulch. Piles with excessive branches or debris **will NOT be picked up**.
- Leaves **should NOT** be piled in such a way that they obstruct the roadway, or any sewer drains or catch basins.
- **Do NOT** pile your leaves around trash bins, mailboxes, vehicles, fire hydrants, etc. They must be at least six feet away from all obstructions. **Leaves piled too close to obstructions will NOT be picked up**.
- Do not bag your leaves if you want them picked up by the township. Instead, bagged waste should be marked as yard waste for Rumpke to pick up.
- If, due to circumstances beyond our control, leaves are not picked up within the scheduled time, they will be picked up as soon as possible.
