

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A 24-HOUR ON-STREET PARKING RESTRICTION IN
PERRY TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Perry Township, Franklin County, Ohio, has determined the public safety and welfare would be served by the following 24-hour on street parking restriction; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has granted townships the authority to pass resolutions on parking of vehicles on township roads pursuant to O.R.C. 505.17; and,

WHEREAS, the regulation does not conflict with the uniform traffic act, and is applicable only to the unincorporated areas of the township;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Perry Township, Franklin County that:

Section 1. No person shall park any vehicle upon the streets or right of ways in the unincorporated areas of Perry Township, Franklin County, Ohio in the same location in excess of 24 hours, whether attended or unattended.

Section 2. Any vehicle parked in violation of this resolution may be order towed by any Perry Township Police officer as a designated agent of the Perry Township Board of Trustees. The owner or lien holder of a vehicle ordered towed may claim the vehicle upon presentation of proof of ownership, which may be evidenced by a certificate of title to the vehicle and payment of all expenses, charges and fines incurred as a result of this parking violation and removal and storage of the vehicle.

Section 3. Owners of vehicles parked in violation of parking regulations will be notified by having a Perry Township Police parking ticket affixed to the vehicle in a manner apparent to the driver of the vehicle

Section 4. Pursuant to ORC 4521.02(A), parking infractions shall not be considered criminal offenses for any purpose and a person who commits a violation shall not be arrested as a result of the commission of the violation;

Section 5. The fine for a first violation of parking regulations shall be \$50; the fine for a second violation of parking regulations shall be \$75; and the fine for third or more violations shall be \$100. All fines must be answered within 14 business days of the offense. Fines may be paid in person at the Perry Township Police Department Administrative Office located at 7125 Sawmill Road, Dublin, Ohio between 8AM and 4PM, Monday through Friday or mailed to 7125 Sawmill Road, Dublin, Ohio. Checks will be made payable to Perry Township.

Section 6. These regulations are subject to the limitations, restrictions and exceptions in ORC Chapter 4511 and ORC sections 4513.02 to 4513.37.

Section 7. The regulated parking areas outlined above shall be further designated by the installation of traffic control devices conforming to ORC section 4511.09

Section 8. The Township Fiscal Officer is directed to post these regulations in five (5) conspicuous public places in the Township for thirty (30) days and publish the same in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks.

Section 9. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 10. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
