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TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Applicant agrees to complete all work to be performed under this application as soon as reasonably possible and to completely restore the entire road and Right-of-Way to the condition that existed before such work was undertaken or better, in accordance with the Perry Township Right-of-Way Regulations and Guidelines for Excavation Permits. No application or fee shall be required for an excavation project to install five or fewer poles for the purpose of providing electric or telecommunications service, but the person making that excavation shall provide verifiable notice of the excavation to the township fiscal officer at least three business days prior to the date of the excavation.
2. Applicant agrees to notify Worthington Fire & EMS or the Upper Arlington Fire Division, depending on the project location, and all utility providers of the road excavation AND to obtain all required permits prior to the commencement of any work or excavation in the road Right-of-Way.
3. Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Perry Township, its Board of Trustees, and all officers, employees, and agents of the Township, for any loss or cost, liability, damage, claim, demand, or cause of action arising from, under, or connected with the excavations and work covered by this application.
4. This application is accompanied by a \$50.00 application fee. Said fee shall be returned to applicant if the application is denied. The \$50.00 application fee is waived for Perry Township homeowners replacing sidewalks, driveway aprons, and curbs or other minor installations in front of their individual place of residence. Such minor installations include electric fences
5. Plans, as required by Section 3 of the Perry Township Right-of-Way Regulations and Guidelines for Excavation Permits, are attached to this application. For Perry Township homeowners replacing sidewalks, driveway aprons, and curbs in front of their individual place of residence, a simple sketch will suffice. That sketch shall include all width, length, and depth of the sidewalks, driveway aprons, and curbs that are to be replaced.
6. Pursuant to Section 5571.16 of the Ohio Revised Code this application is accompanied by a deposit or bond in the amount of \$ _____ (\$150.00 per square yard of pavement to be cut; minimum deposit \$500.00) which shall be refunded to applicant upon performance of all conditions and agreements contained in this application and in the Perry Township Right-of-Way Regulations and Guidelines for Excavation Permits.
7. Applicant certifies that a copy of the Right-of-Way Guidelines for Excavation Permits has been received.
